Professional dress code for all sessions and competitive event activities includes:

Females:

- Blazer or business suit with dress blouse
- Skirt or dress slacks with dress blouse or dress sweater. DECA blazer
- Dress shoes (pumps, heels, flats)

NOT ALLOWED:

- Athletic/sports shoes or sandals
- Anything denim or denim like
- Casual and baggy sweaters, tops or pants
- Leggings
- Flannel shirts or T-shirts

Males:

- Business suit with collared dress shirt and tie
- Sport coat with dress slacks, collared shirt and tie with dress slacks. DECA blazer
- Belt, dress shoes and dress socks

NOT ALLOWED:

- Athletic/sport shoes or sandals
- Anything denim or denim like
- Flannel shirts or T-shirts
- Casual and baggy sweaters, tops or pants
